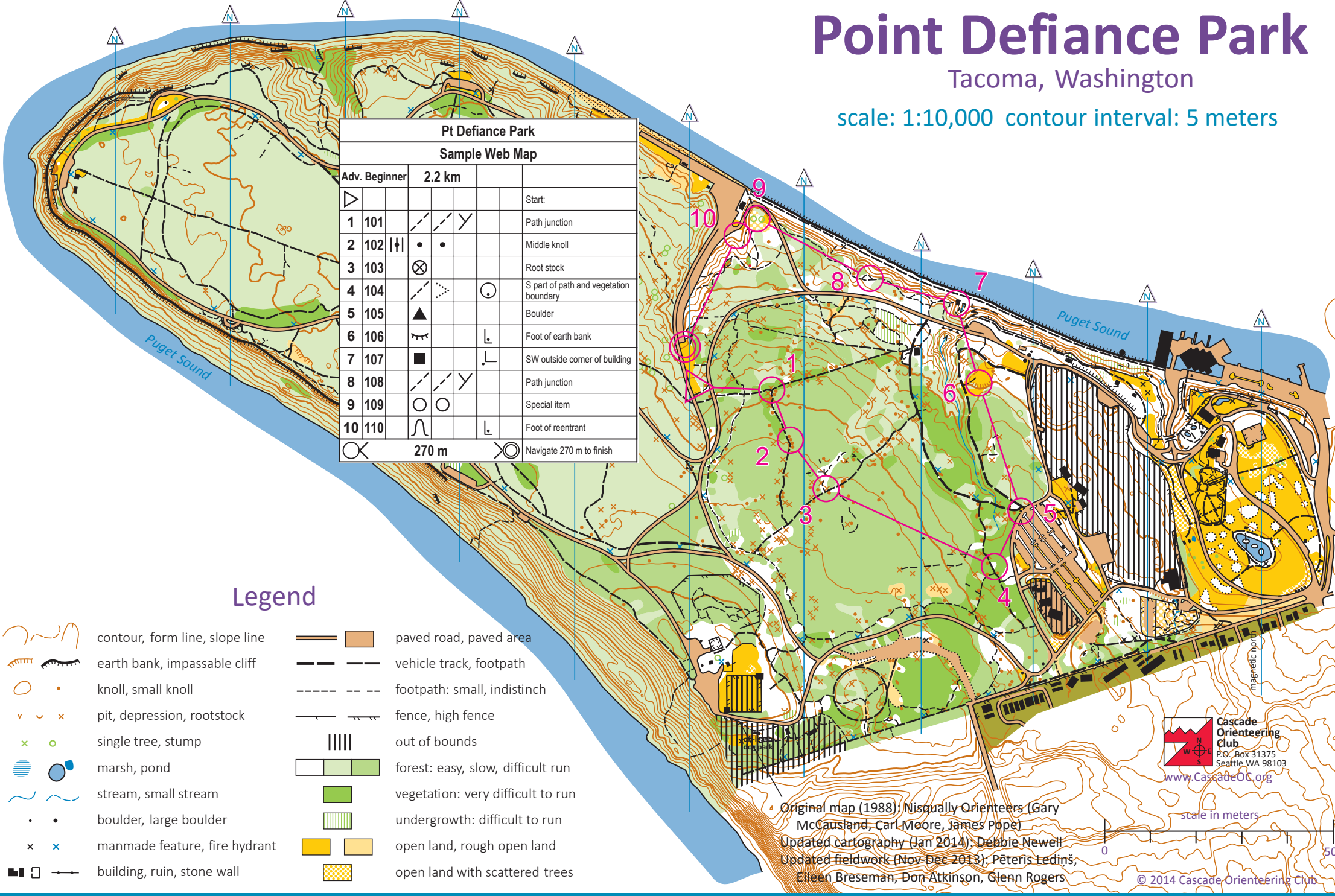


Point Defiance Park
