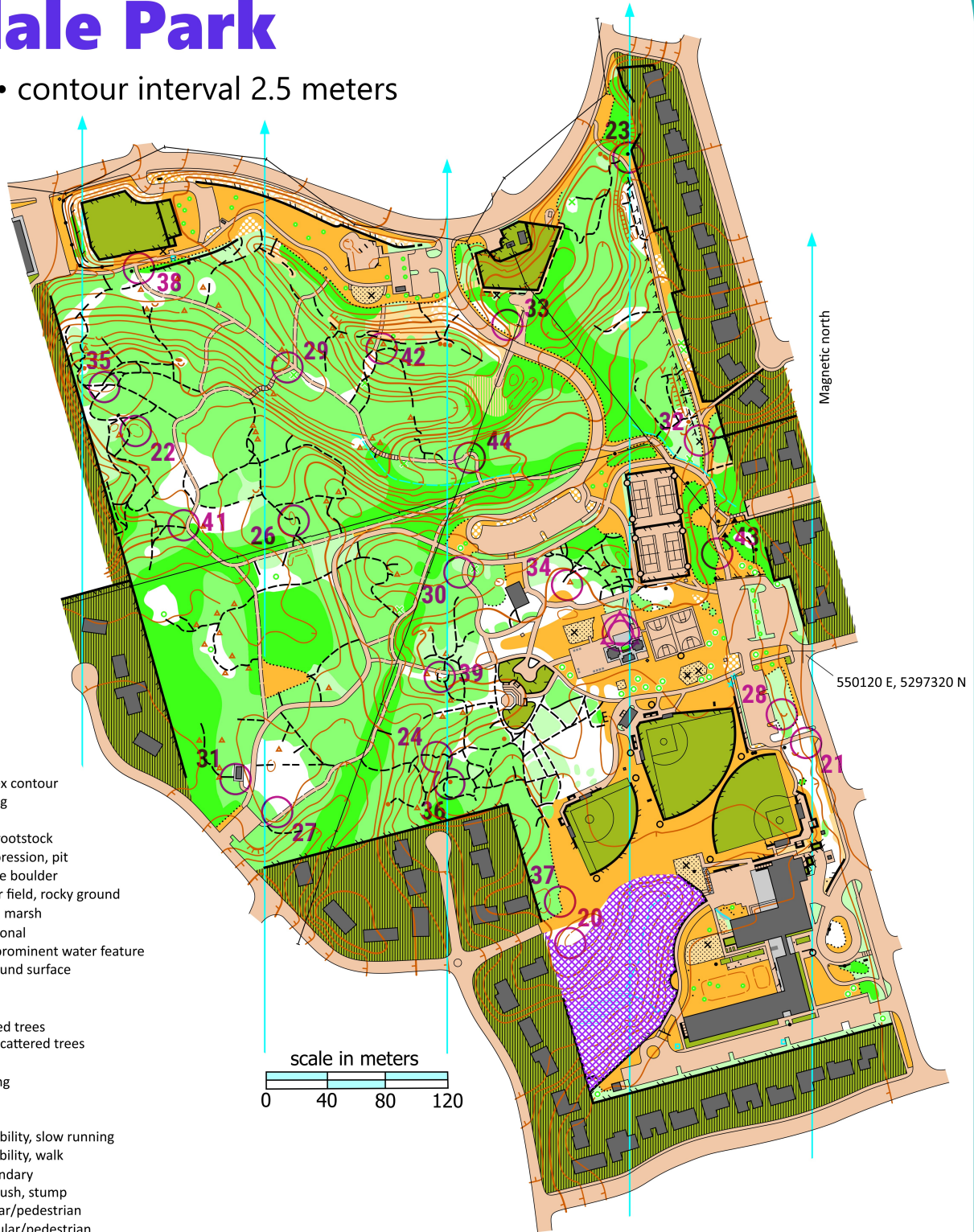


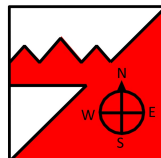
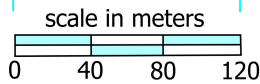
Lynndale Park
